ARTICLE IV. Organization

Section 1. **Officers.** The officers of the League shall consist of President, Vice President and Treasurer (“Officers”). The Officers shall be elected at the annual conference ~~in each even-numbered year,~~ and shall hold their office ~~for two years or until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified.~~ AS FOLLOWS:

- (i) OFFICERS ELECTED AT THE 2021 ANNUAL CONFERENCE SHALL HOLD THEIR OFFICE FOR TWO YEARS OR UNTIL THEIR SUCCESSORS HAVE BEEN DULY ELECTED AND QUALIFIED; AND
- (ii) OFFICERS ELECTED AT OR AFTER THE 2022 ANNUAL CONFERENCE SHALL HOLD THEIR OFFICE FOR ONE YEAR OR UNTIL THEIR SUCCESSORS HAVE BEEN DULY ELECTED AND QUALIFIED.
